Greetings and best wishes to you all. I am pleased to send you this Foundation for Children in Need annual Report. FCN has made tremendous progress. Today, FCN provides sponsorship help to 2,000 needy children and college students while providing assistance to the elderly and medical care for poor villagers who often lack access to hospitals. Thousands are helped through our free medical services. With the help of a medical team from the USA and local surgeons, FCN has coordinated free surgeries for 2,000 children born with Cleft Lip and Cleft Palate in the past nine years. We were able to distribute 35,000 notebooks and 1500 school bags to needy children in rural villages. We also distributed 16,175 masks and 6,900 new clothing for needy children and poor people.

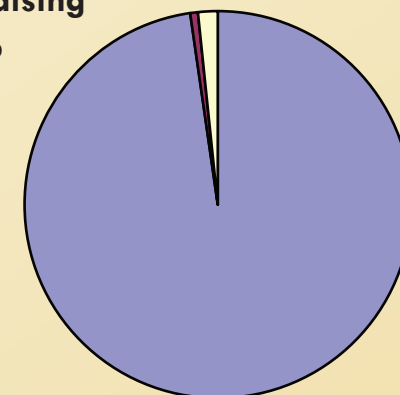
